A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
BUCKEYE EXCAVATING FOR THE OAK STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Buckeye Excavating shall be awarded a contract for the Oak Street Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that in order to compete the Agreement, the council must give its approval and authorize that Mayor or Village Administrator to enter into that Agreement, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Grafton that the project be completed, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor or Village Administrator, on behalf of the Village of Grafton, be permitted and directed to enter into an agreement with Buckeye Excavating which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and incorporated herein by reference.
- Section 2. That the amount of the Agreement is not to exceed Nine Hundred Seven Thousand Seventy Nine Dollars and Forty Cents (\$907,079.40) base bid with alternate bid #1 at a cost of Nineteen Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$19,700.00), for a total cost of Nine Hundred Twenty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars and Forty Cents (\$926,779.40) as per Agreement.
- Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the reservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grafton, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of adopting a Resolution to provide for the public health within the Village of Grafton, Ohio.


Section 5. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect as soon as permitted by law after its passage and approval.
