A RESOLUTION APPROVING EASEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN SCOTT SEILER AND INEZ SEILER AND THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Scott Seiler and Inez Seiler are prepared to enter into an Easement Agree with the Village of Grafton relative to their granting the Village of Grafton an easement upon their property, the terms of which are detailed more fully in the Easement Agreement and Addendum to Easement Agreement, attached hereto together as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Council for the Village of Grafton desires to approve and accept the terms of the Easement Agreement and Addendum to Easement Agreement upon its execution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Grafton, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That, Council of the Village of Grafton hereby approves and accepts the terms of the Easement Agreement and Addendum to Easement Agreement by and between Scott Seiler and Inez Seiler as Grantors and the Village of Grafton as Grantee, which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That, the Clerk-Treasurer be and she is hereby directed to issue a check to Scott Seiler and Inez Seiler in the amount of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), upon the execution of the Easement Agreement and Addendum to Easement Agreement.

Section 3. That this Resolution be, and hereby is, declared to be an emergency measure necessary to provide for the public health, peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Grafton, Ohio, the emergency being the necessity of entering into an Easement Agreement so the Village's Oak Street Improvement Project can immediately proceed according to schedule.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be enforce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


