VILLAGE OF GRAFTON ORDINANCE NO. 18-010

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF NEW MATTER IN THE UPDATED AND REVISED CODIFIED ORDINANCES; PUBLISHING THE ENACTMENT OF SUCH NEW MATTER; REPEALING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has completed its annual updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances of the Village, and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature that have been passed by Council since the date of the previous updating and revision of the Codified Ordinances (December 31, 2016) have been included in the Codified Ordinances of the Village, and

WHEREAS, certain changes were made in the Codified Ordinances to bring Village law into conformity with State law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the Village, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances:

Section 2: That the following sections of the Codified Ordinances are or contain new matter in the Codified Ordinances and are hereby approved, adopted and enacted:

402.22, 402.24, 402.53, 404.03, 416.13, 432.155, 432.32, 434.01, 434.09, 452.06, 476.01, 476.03, 476.04, 476.08, 612.07, 624.01, 624.13, 636.045, 642.05

- Section 3: That all ordinances or parts thereof which are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of the new matter adopted by Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance except as follows:
 - A. The enactment of such sections and subsections shall not be construed to affect a right or liability accrued or incurred under any legislative provision prior to the effective date of such enactment, or an action or proceeding for the enforcement of such right or liability. Such enactment shall not be construed to relieve any person from punishment for an act committed in violation of any such legislative provision, nor to affect an indictment or prosecution therefor. For such purposes, any such legislative provision shall continue in full force notwithstanding its repeal for the purpose of revision and recodification.
 - B. The repeal provided above shall not affect any legislation enacted subsequent to January 16, 2018.
- Section 4: That pursuant to Ohio R.C. 731.23 and 731.25 and Section 222.01 of the Codified Ordinances, the Clerk-Treasurer shall post a copy of this ordinance, together with a summary of the new matter adopted by it, a copy of which summary, identified as Exhibit A, is attached hereto, for a period of not less than 15 days in the five public places set forth in Section 222.01 of the Codified Ordinances.
- Section 5: That this action was in the best interest of the Village and that it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio R.C. 121.22.
