AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS OF MONEY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, LORAIN COUNTY, AND STATE OF OHIO, FOR THE PERIOD ENDING MARCH 31, 2019 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

AN ORDINANCE to make appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Grafton, State of Ohio, during the period ending March 31, 2019.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, LORAIN COUNTY AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 3. That the Village Clerk-Treasurer be and is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village Treasury for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certification and voucher therefore, approve by the officer authorized by law to approve the same or any ordinance or resolution of Council to make expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of two thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the Village, and for purpose other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 4. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the requirements of Section 121.11 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grafton, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of adopting local Ordinances to maintain the public peace and safety within the Village of Grafton, Ohio.
