AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING MONIES FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE STREET MAINTENANCE & REPAIR FUND OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Nineteen Dollars and Forty Six Cents (\$13,119.46) be transferred from the State Highway Improvement Fund 202.602.52700 to the Street Maintenance & Repair Fund 201.602.41910 per State Auditor.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meeting open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Grafton, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of adopting an Ordinance to provide for the public health within the Village of Grafton, Ohio.
