AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1290.05 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, PERTAINING TO PAVING

WHEREAS, Council has determined it necessary, and in the best interests of the Village of Grafton and its citizenry, to amend Chapter 1290.05, and require that any improvements made to Aprons, Sidewalks, and Driveways on residential streets or in planned developments with concrete streets, be improved only with approved materials. Any person desiring to replace or resurface any apron, sidewalk, or driveway located on a residential street or in a planned development, shall first submit an application to the Village, on a form provided by the Village, and shall provide any and all pertinent information required on such application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Grafton, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> That, Chapter 1290.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Grafton shall be amended as follows:

1290.05 PAVING.

The required number of parking and loading spaces as set forth in this chapter, together with driveways, drive aisles, and other circulation areas, shall be improved with acceptable impervious material to provide a durable and dust-free surface, typically Portland cement concrete or asphaltic concrete. Any improvement(s) made to aprons, sidewalks, and driveways on residential streets must be improved using material(s) which shall be first approved by the Village Administrator or Village Engineer. Any improvement(s) made to aprons, sidewalks, and driveways in planned developments with concrete streets must be improved using like-kind material(s) which shall be first approved by the Village Administrator or Village Engineer. Any person desiring to replace or resurface any apron, sidewalk or driveway located on a residential street or in a planned development shall first submit a completed application, on a form provided by the Village, detailing the improvement(s) to be made and the material(s) to be used thereon, to the Village Administrator or Village Engineer for approval.

Section 2. That, it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> That, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the earliest date allowed by law.
